Asami Yoshiga is a graduate of the Japanese Painting at the Graduate School of Art and Design, Musashino Art University. She has continued to create works with depth by layering cloths painted with beautiful landscapes using *sumi* (Japanese Ink) and ink. Her works transcend the technical and formal framework of traditional Japanese painting and two-dimensional painting and embodying narratives. Furthermore, the layered images not only convey spatial depth but also express a temporal flow. When viewers confront Yoshiga's works, they are transported into the pieces, and the "landscapes" depicted there gradually transform into "scenes." We invite you to enjoy this exhibition by projecting your own memories onto Asami Yoshiga's works.
